

The benches that surround the elevated perimeter walkways of the pods that make up Roskie are crumbling, breaking apart and are no longer structurally sound. Additionally, the walkway elevation in most cases is greater than 30" above the ground. By code, this mandates a guardrail. Currently the existing benches do not meet this requirement, which poses a safety concern. These conditions were noted during the precast canopy demo, but due to monetary constraints, funding for the demo and replacement of the benches has been deferred until now. The proposal before UFPB includes the addition of a guardrail to replace the existing benches as a remedy. Photo of the existing condition and sketches of the proposed guardrail are provided below.
