

PROJECT OVERVIEW

MSU is planning to constructing a new dining hall on campus. The dining hall will replace the current Harrison and Hannon dining halls and serve the northeast residential area of campus as well as the academic core. The facility will be approximately 30,000 square feet and have seating for up to 700. Eight potential sites have been identified that could house this new facility. All the sites are located in the NE quadrant of the campus to best serve the residence halls in that area including Hannon, Hapner, Langford, Culbertson, Mullen, Colter, and Pryor Halls.



STAFF COMMENTS:

The Board of Regents recently approved a new dining hall facility for the MSU Bozeman campus. We now need to start the site selection process, so this is coming to UFPB as an informational item at this point. The locations shown are for a preliminary discussion, to get us thinking towards the appropriate location for this facility. The facility will be approximately 32,000 square feet and have about 700 seats.

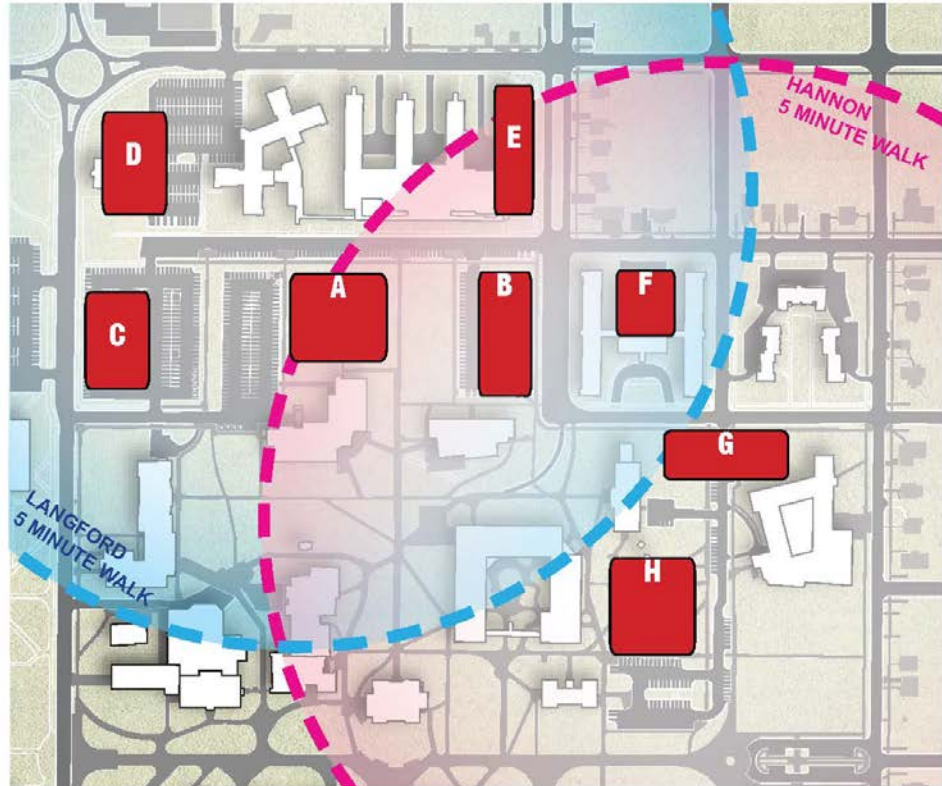
SITE SELECTION

Residence Hall Adjacency:

The new dining hall is primarily intended to serve the student residing in the Northeast area of the campus in Langford, Johnstone Center, Hapner and Hannon Halls.

Locating the dining hall close to the residence halls is important for reducing travel time and increasing security. Travel from the women's residence halls, Hapner and Hannon, is particularly important.

This diagram indicates a 5 minute walking distance from the two most remote halls, Hannon (women), and Langford (men).
