The locations shown are for a preliminary discussion, to get us thinking towards the appropriate location for this facility. The facility will be approximately 32,000 square feet and have about 700 seats.


SITE SELECTION

Residence Hall Adjacency:

The new dining hall is primarily intended to serve the student residing in the Northeast area of the campus in Langford, Johnstone Center, Hapner and Hannon Halls.

Locating the dining hall close to the residence halls is important for reducing travel time and increasing security. Travel from the womens' residence halls, Hapner and Hannon, is particularly important.

This diagram indicates a 5 minute walking distance from the two most remote halls, Hannon (women), and Langford (men).
